


Family Safety Drawing Contest

Contest Rules

Eligibility: Children of NATO or US ID Cardholders ages 3-12, stationed at a NATO or US installation in Belgium, the Netherlands, or Geilenkirchen, Germany. Children of AFN personnel are ineligible.

Dates of Contest: March 15th-April 15th. Winners will be announced at the SHAPE *Family Wellness Fair* on April 20th at the SHAPE Events Center from 14:00-18:00.

Contest: Children submit one drawing illustrating how they or their family practice safety. Themes could show street crossing, safety belts, etc. Themes could show one or several ways to stay safe. This exercise is a fun way for parents or families to discuss safety. The entire drawing should be exclusively drawn by a child, but parents are encouraged to give guidance to very young children. Drawings should be made with portrait orientation, not landscape; entries will be considered for a magazine cover.



Drawings must be on paper with dimensions of 8½x11 inches (standard American) or 210x297mm (A4, standard European). Parents of children must submit their child's drawing with the official entry form. Instructions and entry form available at: <http://benelux.afneurope.net> (AFN Benelux website).

Submitting digitally is preferred, entries (drawing and form) may be emailed to sean.patrick@afn.dma.mil or dropped off at AFN Benelux, Bdg. 318, Rm. 101, Rue Norstad, SHAPE, between 10:00-16:00 (weekdays).

Judging: Three winners are selected by an international panel, *headed by SHAPE Life staff*, by age category: 3-5, 6-9, 10-12. There is no system for determining winner. Drawings should at least be portrait oriented and depict safe living.
